Golden Nymph Awards Call for entries

The Monte-Carlo Television Festival has announced a call for entries for the renowned Golden Nymph Awards to be presented at the 63rd edition taking place 14-18 June 2024.

This year's awards program is now officially open with a timeline as follows:

- Submissions close: Thursday, 21 March 2024

- Official Selection to be announced: May 2024
- Golden Nymph Awards Ceremony: Tuesday, 18 June 2024

The Golden Nymph Awards Competition is divided into three categories: Fiction, News & Documentaries and Prince Rainier III Special Prize.

Six Golden Nymph Awards will be presented in the **Fiction Category**, including Best Film, Best Series, Best Creation, Best Actress, Best Actor, and the Jury Special Prize.

Three Golden Nymph Awards will be presented in the **News & Documentaries Category** including Best News Program, Best Documentary, and the Jury Special Prize.

In partnership with the Prince Albert II of Monaco Foundation, the prestigious **Prince Rainier III Special Prize** will reward the best documentary addressing major environmental issues.

For the **Prince Rainier III Special Prize and Fiction categories**, each program within the Official Selection will be presented to the press and to the public during the Festival through public screenings, conferences, and press activities.

Previous fiction program winners of the globally regarded Golden Nymph Awards include Ten Pound Poms, The Tourist, Borgen, The Killing, Modern Family, Breaking Bad, It's A Sin, Money Heist, The Marvellous Mrs Maisel, Das Boot, Escape at Dannemora and My Brilliant Friend. Previous news and documentaries winners include Life on The Dombas Frontline, The Man Who Played With Fire, Navalny - The Man Putin Couldn't Kill, Erasmus in Gaza, The Diagnosis: COVID-19, Citoyen Nobel, North Korea's Sevret Slaves: Dollar Heroes and 'Abuse and the UN'. A stellar roster of acting talent has also been recognized by the Festival including Warren Brown, Marie Reuther, Patricia Arquette, Phoebe Waller-Bridge, Tony Shalhoub, Thekla Carola Wied, Grégory Montel, Benedict Cumberbatch, Richard Madden, Paul Bettany, Ewan McGregor, Sinéad Keenan, Jenna Coleman and Lydia West. **Laurent Puons, CEO of the Monte-Carlo Television Festival,** says, "The Golden Nymph Awards continue to attract entries from exceptional scripted and factual productions each year. We are delighted to open the awards to producers and distributors for 2024 and very much look forward to seeing a wide range of submissions from around the world."

Within the framework of the **Golden Nymph Awards Competition**, a European panel of TV fans, selected among the BetaSeries community, will bestow a prize to their favorite in the Fiction's Official Selection. The **BetaSeries Public Prize** will be presented during the Golden Nymph Awards Ceremony.

Additional competition prizes related to humanitarian subject matter include the **Prize of the Monaco Red Cross** and the **AMADE Prize.**
