The Bold and the Beautiful is the most watched daytime drama in the world, viewed in more than 100 countries. In May 2024, the series received 12 Daytime Emmy Nominations and has won The TV Audience Award at The Monte Carlo TV Festival a record 13 times. The award is based on worldwide scientific people-meter audience data by Eurodata TV Worldwide. Based on this data, the series holds the Guinness World Record® as "most popular daytime TV soap."

Over the years, the series has filmed episodes internationally on location in Italy, France, Mexico, Denmark, The Netherlands, Australia, Monte Carlo, Abu Dhabi and Dubai. Additionally, the cast has traveled to do press tours, appearances and fan experiences in South Africa, Bulgaria, Iceland, Finland, Belgium, Canada, and Greece.

Among the most surprising places The Bold and the Beautiful is currently broadcast are Botswana, Bulgaria, Fiji, Lithuania, Palestine, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, Syria and the United Arab Emirates.

The Bold and the Beautiful celebrated its 37th anniversary of broadcasting on March 23, 2024. In its 37-year history, The Bold and the Beautiful has received 107 Daytime Emmy® Awards and 340 Daytime Emmy® nominations.

Katherine Kelly Lang has played irresistible beauty "Brooke Logan," the heroine of **The Bold and the Beautiful** who always follows her heart, since Season One, Episode One — March 23, 1987.

Lang is one of three children in a show business family. Her parents are the late Keith Wegeman, an Olympic long jump skier who went on to play television's Jolly Green Giant, and Judith Lang, a film, television, and commercial actress. Her grandfather was Charles Lang, one of the most outstanding cinematographers of Hollywood's Golden Age who was nominated for 18 Academy Awards and won in 1932 for A Farewell to Arms.

Lang began her career at an early age by appearing in print advertisements and commercials. Her first acting role was in Skatetown USA as the lead's (Patrick Swayze) sister. She went on to appear on the television series, Happy Days, Masquerade, Magnum P.I. and Lonesome Dove: The Outlaw Years. Soon after, she was cast as "Gretchen" on The Young and the Restless which lead to appearances on films such as The Nightstalker, Disney Channel's Mr. Boogedy, and 'Til the End of the Night. She also appeared in many of the Beach Boys' music videos, embodying the classic California Girl. Lang has achieved fame and notoriety internationally from her role on The Bold and the Beautiful. This has led to many roles in foreign productions including a guest-star arc on the critically acclaimed Greek television series 8 lexeis, in which she spoke Greek; in the Australian production of I'm a Celebrity Get Me Out of Here, and two Italian films, Odissea Nell' Ospizio and Dagli Occhi dell' Amore. She was also a contestant on Dancing with the Stars, Italy.

Lang has received six Daytime Emmy® nominations and one win. Three nominations are in the category of "Outstanding Lead Actress in a Drama Series" in 2014, 2020, and 2024, and one nomination in the category of "Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Drama Series" in 2013, all for her role on The Bold and the Beautiful. In 2014, Lang was nominated and won a Daytime Emmy® as part of the producing team of the digital drama, Venice the Series.

She is an avid athlete and a devoted philanthropist. Lang is the Ambassador and Spokesperson for Amgen's "Breakaway from Cancer" Foundation, an organization that offers people affected by cancer a broad range of support services. Additionally, she sits on the Board of Directors for "Women for Tri," an organization dedicated to increasing awareness and interest in the sport of triathlon. In October of 2015, Lang represented "Women for Tri" in the Ironman World Championship competition in Kona, HI, a race that consists of a 2.4-mile swim, a 112-mile bike ride, and a 26.2-mile run. She prepared for this competition by participating in Half-Ironman races in South Africa, Abu Dhabi, Oceanside, Pescara, Austria, Florida, and Australia.

In 2020, Lang and her partner, Dominique Zoida, opened their first retail business, Benheart USA, located on Santa Monica Boulevard just off Rodeo Drive, in Beverly Hills. The boutique is the culmination of a partnership between the couple and Benheart's founder, Hicham Benmbarek Sheraian (Ben) who founded the Benheart brand after having a heart transplant in Italy. Benheart USA showcases beautiful and unique luxury Italian leather pieces some handmade right in the boutique. Lang also designs beautifully hand-beaded silk kaftans and accessories that can be purchased at www.katherinekellylangkaftans.com, and on home shopping networks worldwide.

With an enormous love for sports and the outdoors, Lang spends her days off long-distance biking, horseback riding, running and training for triathlons. An accomplished equestrian, she has owned several horses and has competed in 25-mile and 50-mile cross country endurance races. At the special invitation of the Sheik of Qatar, she placed third in the International Desert Marathon in 1996.

Lang lives in Los Angeles with her partner, Dominique Zoida. She is a devoted mother to her children, Julian and Jeremy Snyder, Zoe and Danyelle D'Andrea, and her two grandchildren, Zuma and Reign. She celebrates her birthday on July 25.

Because of his great love for the theater, Kaye starred in many stage productions, including Macbeth and Julius Caesar, as a Hilberry Repertory Theater Company member in Detroit, MI, and trained with Bill Hobbs at London's National Theatre.

In June 2024, Kaye was the recipient of his second back-to-back Daytime Emmy® Award as Lead Actor in a Drama Series for his "Ridge Forrester" role on The Bold and the Beautiful. He received two previous Emmy® nominations in the same category for his work on The Bold and the Beautiful in 2020 and 2021.
